- Takes up to 60 calendar days for USCG approval
- Vessels 400 gt and above
- As per 33 U.S.C. 1321 (j)(5) and
- Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation Act of 2006

- Takes up to 20 working days, after issuance of the ca cofr
- Vessels 300 gt and above

California Certificate of Financial Responsibility - CA COFR

- Takes up to 20 working days to have issued
- Vessels 300 gt and above

California EPA - No Discharge Zone

- Vessels 300 gt and above no discharge of treated or un treated black water

Canada Declaration

- The Canada Declaration is a single document that is kept aboard that proves compliance with Canadian Shipping Act regulations
- Contract with a Certified Response Organization is required
